The Wine & Liquor Company, Inc. d/b/a Christy's Liquors 1350 Oaklawn Ave.

On motion by Council Vice-President Ferri, seconded by Councilman Reilly, it was voted to renew the above liquor license application.

Under Discussion

Solicitor appeared to speak regarding the renewal application for The Wine & Liquor Co. and stated that Attorney Louis DeSimone is present to represent some objectors regarding the renewal application for The Wine & Liquor Co. and Attorney Robert Murray representing The Wine & Liquor Co. He stated that he has been in contact with both attorneys in this situation and they are both present representing their respective clients.

Louis DeSimone, Esq., 1554 Cranston St., appeared to speak and stated that he represents Oaklawn Liquors d/b/a Gasbarros on Oaklawn Ave. and MAD, which is Atwood Liquors located on Atwood Ave. He stated that a transfer was approved on November 4, 2019 to The Wine & Liquor Co., d/b/a Christy's Liquors and the license at that time could not be issued. There was no location, there are several conditions precedent to issuing a license. Those being such things as Certificate from the State, Certificate of Occupancy, proper premise for the license, which he thinks is a proper address. There are certain conditions which are required by the City, such as payment of taxes, the local Fire Marshall needs to approve the location and issue a Certificate as well as the Building Office. Attorney DeSimone indicated to RIGL 3-5-16.1 that provides that when a holder closes operation of a Class A license for more than 90 days, the local licensing authority shall open hearing of abandonment of that license. There is language that a reasonable period of time can be granted not to exceed one year. We are approximately two years from the transfer date of this license. He pointed out to Rule 14 of the Commercial Licensing Regulations, which provides that all retail licenses have a one-year period to complete the conditions of a transfer. He suggested that the license not be renewed this evening and at some point, schedule a hearing for the abandonment according to the Statute. He also pointed to Rule 1.4.27 of the Department of Regulations Rules Ch. 30, subsection 10. Attorney Desimone also referred to the D'Ambra matter, a case in which a license was denied on this basis.

Robert Murray, Esq., appeared to represent The Wine & Liquor Co. and also owner of the property on Oaklawn Ave. he stated that last Friday, he provided to the City Clerk a detailed timeline for the record. Attorney Desimone provided an objection today to the Clerk, which is after the deadline set by the Committee.

Attorney DeSimone stated that he was not aware that this was on the docket when he sent the objection. He did not mean to present that as a piece of evidence.

On motion by Councilman Reilly, seconded by Council Vice-President Ferri, it was voted to accept Attorney Murray's document. Motion passed unanimously.

Attorney Murray stated that The Wine & Liquor Co. formerly operated at 311 Warwick Ave. In 2016, the Committee approved the transfer from the former owner to his client and they operated at that location until 2020. When the license transfer was approved in 2019 to be transferred to Oaklawn Ave., there were no conditions placed on it by the Committee and that was the first step in the process. Attorney Murray reminded the Committee that last September, 2020, the Committee renewed the Class A Liquor License for his client knowing that they were well under way to move forward with the new store. Prior to starting any of this, he was in contact with the Department of Business Regulations, the Senior Legal Counsel involved in Liquor Control issues and he raised this very issue of whether or not his client could discontinue operation at Warwick Ave. until the new store is built and he received an affirmative answer. They said it is clearly the purview of the City Council to put timeframe on license transfers, but that did not happen in this instance. To deny this renewal would be wrong in his opinion.

Roll call was taken on motion to approve the renewal application for The Wine & Liquor Company, Inc. d/b/a Christy's Liquors and motion passed unanimously.
