At your request, the Rhode Island Historical Preservation & Heritage Commission has reviewed the above- referenced subdivision project.

The proposed subdivision will have no effect on any significant above ground resources, and, as currently designed, the project will have no impact on the historical cemetery. However, Native American artifacts were recovered from the project area by 20^{th} -century artifact collectors, and it is possible that undisturbed elements of this site are still present on the property. We recommend an archaeological survey be conducted prior to any ground disturbance to determine if this is the case.
